## 1. What improvements (if any) to bus travel would you MOST like to see introduced in East Sussex?

Friends of Lewes would like to see the focus of improvements on measures that deliver an increased use of public transport throughout East Sussex and a reduction in the number of vehicles passing though Lewes, with a corresponding reduction in vehicle emissions. However, the Society considers this will only be achieved if bus service improvements are supported by a coherent traffic plan for Lewes, which is currently absent.
